

STUDENT WORKER NEEDED IMMEDIATELY!

Interested in gaining experience in an entomology laboratory? We need a student worker for approximately 10-15 hours per week. Duties would include supporting an insecticide resistance monitoring program, maintenance of laboratory insect colonies, cleaning vials and lab dishware, and general laboratory duties. Student must be able to drive own car short distances during summer (good driving record required) and cost of travel will be reimbursed. There is the potential to learn statistics and molecular techniques as well. Hours are very flexible with occasional weekend work required. The salary starts at \$7.50 /hour with the possibility of increase based on performance. The position is available through Dec. 2009, with continuation depending on performance and available funding.
